Our services

Outpatient Clinics

We provide a wide range of specialty clinics and our outpatients team work hard to ensure that we offer good access, personalised care and a positive patient experience.

Bramley Children's Unit

The Bramley is a purpose built area for outpatient services for children and young people, enabling them to receive care at their local hospital. This includes general clinics, allergy, ENT, endocrine, diabetes, respiratory and clinics for urgent referrals.

Therapies

Our therapy teams provide a range of inpatient and outpatient services. We provide assessment, rehabilitation and pre and post-operative treatment to inpatients, while our outpatient therapy services include neurological, hand therapy, rheumatology, women's health, musculoskeletal, respiratory and cardiac rehabilitation.

Medical Day Case

We now offer a range of medical day case procedures at Newark Hospital including infusions, transfusions, rheumatology treatments, gastroenterology treatments, and haematology treatments.

Diagnostics

We are able to offer a wide range of tests on site including X Ray, ultrasound, CT imaging, MRI scanning and diagnostic endoscopy procedures.

Inpatient Services

Our 24 bed sub-acute Sconce ward provides a positive and welcoming environment so that people feel at ease through a difficult time in their lives. Our focus is on quality patient care.

We receive patients from other hospitals following their acute episode of care who can continue to be treated nearer to their home. We also take a number of patients that require decision making on discharge planning and/or the next place of care helping to prevent unnecessary delays.

Fernwood Community Unit

Fernwood is our 12 bed rehabilitation unit which takes patients from an acute episode of care in another hospital, or from their GP or a community service, for a short period of intensive rehabilitation. The team pride themselves on their holistic approach and personalised care and frequently go above and beyond to maximise the rehab potential for their patients.

Urgent Care

Our Newark Urgent Care Centre is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week, to treat urgent but not life threatening conditions. The purpose built area allows people to be treated and to return home as quickly as possible and we are proud of the service's consistently high performance in providing patients with timely care.

Other Services

Newark Hospital also offers a range of other services including orthotics, sexual health, midwifery, respiratory care, phlebotomy and pre-operative assessment.
